FireEye was alerted of a potential security issue impacting the FireEye website. The below issue was fixed and no further user action is required. We appreciate the effort of security researchers and the research community.

**FireEye Label: FireEye Website Susceptible to Clickjacking**

**Severity:** Low

**Products Affected:** FireEye Website

**Description:** A vulnerability existed within the FireEye website allowing an attacker to manipulate a web user into clicking on a different website than what the web user expected.
